

# Can ChatGPT Help You Learn French? Here's the Truth

This week, I'm sharing a realistic look at **how you can use ChatGPT** to support your French practice and where it falls short. You'll find **practical tips, clear examples, and prompts you can copy** and try right away.

But first... I just reached 10K on TikTok this week! I didn't expect it to happen this fast, and while I know it's not huge or anything, I'm really happy about it. I tend to forget to celebrate my own wins (*maybe just like you do sometimes with your French progress?*), so I'm making an effort to notice this one.

Now, let's look at what ChatGPT *can* do for your French... and what it *can't*.

## What ChatGPT can do:

- · Correct grammar and spelling in your writing
- Explain grammar points (especially if you ask clear questions)
- Create fill-in-the-blank exercises
- Simplify complex French to match your level
- Simulate casual conversations in voice mode (only in the app) if you want clear, slow, customizable French. You can ask it to repeat, slow down, or explain. But be aware: the voice can sound a bit robotic, and it's not quite like real-world speech.
- Respond instantly, 24/7
- Give you a free, low-pressure space to experiment

# X What it can't do:

- · Hear your pronunciation or help with rhythm and flow
- Catch subtle tone or register issues
- Teach cultural nuance: tone, politeness, humour, emotion
- Understand why you're making certain mistakes
- Build a learning journey: it reacts, but doesn't guide
- Replace real conversation, encouragement, or human connection

### So what's the verdict?

ChatGPT can be a great addition to your French learning toolbox but it's not a one-size-fits-all solution. Use its strengths, and **combine it with other tools** to build what it can't offer: guidance, speaking, and real connection.

#### Want to try? Here are a few prompts

- 1. **Grammar:** "You're a French teacher. Can you explain the difference between *depuis*, *pendant*, and *il y a*? Please give simple explanations and a few everyday examples."
- 2. **Vocabulary**: "You're a French teacher. Teach me 10 natural ways to say "*tired*" in French (both formal and informal) with short example sentences for each one."
- 3. **Exercices**: "You're a French teacher. Create a short fill-in-the-blanks exercise to practice the present tense of common -er verbs. Include 5 sentences and give the correct answers at the end."
- 4. **Writing**: "You're a French teacher. I'll write a short paragraph in French. Please correct any mistakes and explain why in simple French. Be kind but clear!"
- 5. **Reading comprehension**: "You're a French teacher. Can you write a short B1-level text (5 to 6 sentences) on a daily topic, then ask me 3 simple comprehension questions about it?"
- 6. Conversation practice (voice mode): "Pretend you're my French friend. Ask me 5 casual questions about my weekend. Wait for my answers, and respond naturally." or "Pretend you're a French server at a café. I'm coming in to order something. Ask me questions like you normally would. Wait for my answers, and correct me if I make mistakes. Use natural, friendly French."
